18hr. VIRTUAL Nurturing Program Facilitator Training

The three-day training focuses on understanding the philosophy of nurturing parenting, assessing high risk parenting beliefs and environments, and implementing programs at the primary, secondary's, and tertiary levels of prevention. Participants will also learn how to monitor the success of families through process and outcome-based evaluations. Many strategies will be provided to measure the attainment of parenting attitude, knowledge, and skills. This program can be conducted through a telehealth system individually or in groups. Participants will also learn how to provide telehealth Seven Step Fidelity Implementation™ and the importance of administering and scoring the online versions of the Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory.

In four days, participants will learn:

- The Nurturing Program philosophy
- The five parenting constructs of abuse and neglect
- How to assess high-risk parenting beliefs
- o The Seven Step Fidelity Implementation™
- o The effectiveness of individual and group-based models through Telehealth
- How to tailor programs to address family's diverse needs
- How to gather process evaluation data
- How to evaluate pre-post program impact
