

VIRTUAL Nurturing Program AAPI, NSCS & PARTI Assessment Training

The Family Nurturing Center of Texas offers a virtual training experience for assessing family functioning and parenting risk using:

- AAPI (Adult Adolescent Parenting Inventory)
- NSCS (Nurturing Skills Competency Scale)
- PARTI (Parenting Attitudes about Raising Teens Inventory)

In this training, using AAPI, NSCS, and PARTI, participants learn to assess risks in family functioning using the Adult Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI), Nurturing Skills Competency Scale (NSCS), and Parenting Attitudes about Raising Teens Inventory (PARTI) assessment tools.

- AAPI is a validated and reliable inventory used to assess parenting attitudes. Over 33 years of research has gone into refining the AAPI, and AAPI-2 has been used for almost a decade to evaluate the Nurturing Parenting Program.
- The Nurturing Skills Competency Scale (NSCS) is a comprehensive criterion referenced measure designed to gather demographic data of the family, as well as knowledge and utilization of Nurturing Parenting practices.
- PARTI is a norm- reference Likert scale designed to assess the parenting beliefs and practices of raising adolescent's ages 12 to 20 years of age.

Participants learn to administer pre- and post- assessments to yield the best results, to interpret the scores, and to apply this knowledge to provide quality implementation. This training should be taken after the initial three-day Nurturing Program facilitation training, preferably within the first two to three months of running your nurturing program.

WHO CAN BENEFIT?

Professionals and paraprofessionals working in education, behavioral health, violence prevention, child welfare, Head Start, school systems, treatment facilities, social work, and social services can all benefit from this training.
